#### do not encroach

If your child is struggling emotionally or physically it can be tough but - serious injuries aside - please don't encroach onto the pitch during a match unless invited on by coaches or officials.

### eave differences at the door

We know that not everyone gets along but you're there to support the children. Leave your differences in the car, no child wants to see their adult(s) fighting in front of them.

## watch the flippin' language

Many parents get surprised by just how into an event they get but please remember where you are and keep the language environment-appropriate!

## give a pass on the puffing

Your child's debut or just a tense match can be a nerve-wracking experience but please try to avoid smoking cigarettes or vaping on the side of the pitch and around the children.
